

From the Rabbi's Study: Endorsing Propositions from the Pulpit

When I delivered my Yom Kippur sermon on prison reform this year, I endorsed Proposition 47, which appeared on the November ballot. Prop 47, which voters passed, reduces from felonies to misdemeanors certain low-level, non-violent crimes such as petty theft and personal use of some drugs. Some congregants worried that my endorsement would jeopardize the 501(c)3, non-profit status of our synagogue.

I would like to set the record straight as this view is incorrect. According to the IRS, a congregation or a member of the clergy is entitled to support ballot propositions but *not* candidates for public office. Specifically, let me cite the guidelines put out by the Religious Action Center of Reform Judaism (RAC) on this subject, which read in part:

- Congregations can take positions on public policy issues, including ballot initiatives and legislation, where their values are implicated. Activities such as public education campaigns, petitioning, joining coalitions and meeting with elected officials are acceptable. Such activities are considered lobbying. [Congregations and clergy, along with other nonprofit charitable organizations, MAY participate in public policy advocacy (lobbying) to a limited degree.]
- Congregations may organize non-partisan voter registration and get-out-the-vote drives.
- Congregations may host candidate forums/debates as long as all candidates meeting pre-set, objective and non-partisan criteria are invited. The forum must be for the purpose of public education, and the issues and format may not favor a particular candidate or party.

As a general rule, synagogues and clergy, acting in an official capacity, *may not* engage in activities on behalf of, or in opposition to, any particular party or candidate for office at any level of government. You must remain non-partisan; even the perceived appearance of partisanship can result in your 501(c)3 status being revoked. Specifically:

- Temples and clergy acting in an official capacity may not endorse candidates; for clergy, that extends to messages from the pulpit and bulletin articles.
- Congregations may not post signs favoring a party or candidate on their property.

As you can see, no IRS rules were broken at Yom Kippur. There is one thing I would do differently in the future, however. I had asked staff to pass out information sheets on the proposition as congregants walked into the service. The sheets were entitled, "Vote Yes on Proposition 47." My intention had been to provide background on the proposition, but in

retrospect, the manner of distribution and the title of the sheet might have made it look as though the Temple officially endorsed the proposition. That was not the case, as I had not asked the board to do so. I am sorry the wrong impression might have been given.

When I speak about matters of social justice from the pulpit or in bulletin articles, I draw from the Jewish values that I think should drive our ethics and our behavior. I believe that it is my responsibility as your rabbi to focus your attention on matters of pressing concern to our community and to our society, and to make the connection to our history and our tradition. I hope that I do this in a manner that is respectful of differing points of view. I am always open to dialogue about statements I make from the pulpit and elsewhere, so please feel free to call or email me to set up a time to talk. I look forward to healthy debates about all sorts of topics. Because, after all, it is in our nature as Jews to question and to challenge.

Legacy Fund Update

Since 2007, the amount allocated from the Legacy Fund now exceeds \$35,000. Recently \$1,200 was committed towards the attendance of four Confirmation students to the L'Taken Seminar in Sacramento in May 2014. We were very pleased by the response of our students to this opportunity.

Our Yom HaShoah Program was enhanced by the showing of the film "Numbered" and a presentation by a speaker on the subject of Holocaust films. Rabbi Singer has submitted a variety of applications for programs to enhance our congregation's experiences, such as "Judaism You Can Use" given by Rabbi Jill Zimmerman.

However, we have not heard from you, our congregants, with suggestions on programs or projects that are important to you. To qualify, the activity must meet the criteria of "supporting Judaism and enhancing Jewish life" and be submitted 90 days prior to the event.
